### **Proposed Development of the Car Park**

On the 11<sup>th</sup> January Southwark Council began a consultation on a proposal by the owners of the freeholders of the Champion Hill stadium (DHPD Ltd) to build flats on the car park adjacent to the ground.

Clearly this scheme has the potential to affect Dulwich Hamlet Football Club and its supporters both directly (through changes to the current amenities and access) and indirectly (perhaps by changing the Club's financial position).

The news has already provoked discussion amongst supporters, including some people apparently thinking that the football club will have to move to a new ground.

In the circumstances, I would like to propose that the club explains to its supporters as soon as possible what the implications for its future are. The best way of doing this would be to hold a forum for supporters after a forthcoming Saturday home game at which the club could explain the position and take questions.

I would also repeat our request to meet as soon as possible to discuss this issue alongside that of the 100 Club money as set out in my letter of 14<sup>th</sup> December.

Communicating in this positive way would enable the Supporters' Trust and the club's fans more generally to take a view as to whether or not to support the proposed development.

Please note that as a membership-based organisation we will inform our members about this proposal and will be issuing a press release to that end.
